Classically Homeschooling Planning Sheets

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These are the planning sheets I use when planning my year. I fill in the top with each child's name and grade then fill out the curriculum I plan to use for each subject. The check boxes indicate if I have the curriculum. If the box is unchecked, I need to purchase that item.

If you plan to do something free-form that doesn't require a curriculum, simply write in a brief description of your plans. For instance science may be nature study + library books.

This planner gives me an over view of what the children are studying next year, what I need to purchase, and what I may want to change.

Another option is to print one sheet per child and fill in your plans for the next 4 years. This also helps to give cohesion to your child's studies and let you know where you're headed.

I do recommend printing one sheet per high school student plus one extra sheet to note the state's or universities' high school graduation requirements for high school. Either print the one with the highest requirements

This way you can have an overview of what you plan for all 4 years, and a good idea of what you need to cover.
